

Rebus offers several free resources to textbook creators and other OER professionals. The Open Publishing Projects Certificate builds on these offerings with additional personalized support and continued guidance throughout the creation process. Designed for cross-institutional teams, this is a cohort-based certificate facilitated by program alumni. The program is one year long and comprises three phases:







